## Create a Shared Page

Share your messages and locations with others by creating a SPOT Shared Page. Anyone with the link to your Shared Page can see your GPS locations online, anytime, providing a breadcrumb trail of where you are in real-time. You control your Shared Page: Make it public or password protect it; create and delete pages anytime; select what information is shown. You can create up to 10 different SPOT Shared Pages per SPOT device.

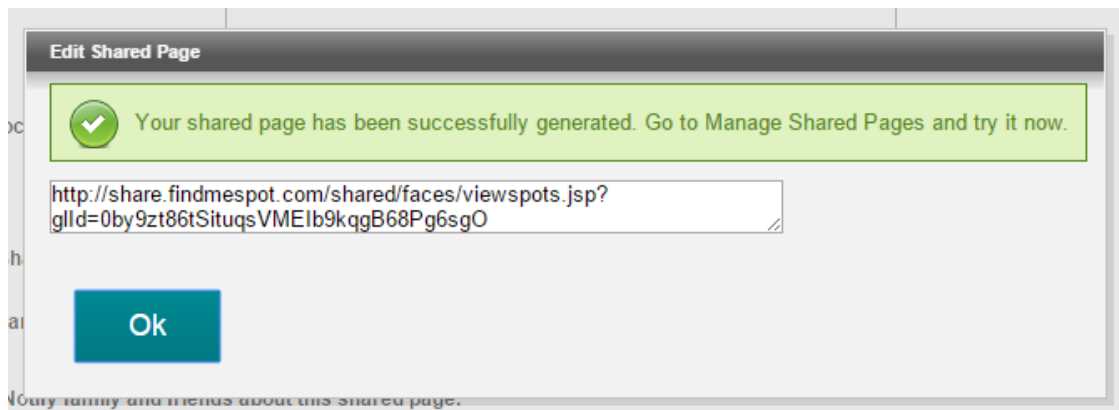

## Setup FINDMESPOT & Spotwalla links



## Setup FINDMESPOT & Spotwalla links

**NOTE:** it is recommended that you create a FINDMESPOT Shared Page for each year in total only (eg. 2015 & 2016 etc), however create a NEW SPOTWALLA trip for each adventure using the original FINDMESPOT link created for that year.


